Whether you're planning a few day trips to beat the heat or a longer stay-cation to reconnect with home, don't miss these Orlando gems:

CULTURE:

Spend the day at Lake Formosa, Rowena, or Estelle surrounding Loch Haven Park and enjoy a waterside picnic beneath the shade of an old oak tree. Known as Orlando's cultural park, this beautiful area is home to the Orlando Museum of Art, Mennello Museum of American Art, Orlando Philharmonic Orchestra, Orlando Repertory Theatre, Orlando Science Center, Orlando Shakespeare Theater, Orlando Fire Museum, and the Orlando Garden Club. Some of these institutions offer free admission on certain days and family-friendly events; visit their websites for the inside scoop.

ENTERTAINMENT:

Outdoor movie nights can be found throughout the Orlando area, but you can't beat the fun at Lake Eola Park's Movieola. Bring your chairs, blankets, snacks, and leashed pets on the last Friday of each month for activities like croquet and cornhole beginning at 6:00pm and a family-friendly movie at 8:15pm. Or take a short drive to Maitland to hang out with the grown-ups at the Enzian Theater's Wednesday Night Pitcher Show for delicious drinks and a free movie on the lawn.

THE GREAT OUTDOORS:

Hike, birdwatch, canoe, or kayak, then relax and swim in the cool clear water at Wekiwa Springs State Park. Get there before 10:00am on the weekends to beat the crowds or camp out for some of the best star-gazing in the state. If birdwatching inspires you to fly, head out to Wallaby Ranch and go hang gliding. After soaring 2,000 feet in the air, the grounds will welcome you with amenities like a 7-foot deep swimming pool, a climbing wall, and a children's playground complete with a Dr. Seuss tree house, in addition to 15 miles of mountain bike and walking trails. Want to enjoy Orlando's wildlife and remain seated? Cruise the 11-mile Lake Apopka Wildlife Drive along the north shore. With over 362 species of birds here as well as alligators, bobcats, otters, and other wildlife, you're bound to see something great.
